SPRINGBORO - FRANKLIN CLUB RULES

- (1) Each New Group shall have an annual chairperson and two additional leaders who shall have at least two (2) years of continuous sobriety and who shall agree to be responsible for the weekly meetings of the New Group for at least one (1) year from the date the New Group begins its meetings at the Club.
- (2) Each Group meeting at the Club shall donate 60% of its contributions to the Club. Any AA or Al-Anon meetings at the Club which are not Groups shall donate 100% of its contributions to the Club. A Group shall mean an AA meeting that (i) has elected an Annual Chairperson, Treasurer and such other officers, if any, as they deem appropriate, and (ii) has decided to become an AA Group in accordance with the Twelve AA Traditions.
- (3) The Club shall issue two (2) keys to the Club to the Annual Chairperson of each Group. The Annual Chairperson shall be responsible for these keys and shall promptly inform the Club if any of the keys are lost or stolen. Each Group shall be responsible to notify the Club of the names and phone numbers of the Annual Chairperson, Treasurer and any other officers of the Group.
- (4) Each Group, and its members and guests, shall abide by the current and any future Rules and Regulations of the Club including, but not limited to, the following:
 - (a) No person shall (i) engage in any unruly behavior on or about the Club, (ii) use offensive or profane language on or about the Club, or (iii) engage in any sexual or psychological harassment of any other person on or about the Club.
 - (b) No alcoholic beverages or drugs of any type will be permitted in the Club.
 - (c) No smoking or use of any tobacco products is permitted in the Club.
 - (d) No firearms, knives or other dangerous weapons of any type will be permitted in or about the Club.
 - (e) No gambling or game-playing of any kind is permitted in the Club, except as authorized by the Club.
 - (f) No pets of any type are permitted in the Club.
 - (g) No discharging of any type of fireworks is permitted in or about the Club.
 - (h) Parking will only be permitted in areas designated by the Club.
 - (i) No chairs or tables shall be moved outside of the Club.
 - (j) No person shall be entitled to a key to the Club, or to duplicate a key to the Club, except as authorized by the Club.
- (5) Each Group shall be responsible for opening and closing the Club prior to and following its meeting. No meetings shall be held by any Group except for (i) its regularly scheduled weekly meeting, and (ii) such special meetings as have been approved in advance by the Club.
- (6) Each Group shall conduct its meeting in an orderly manner and not permit any unruly conduct of its attendees. Each Group shall leave the Club in an orderly condition with all lights turned off and the heat and air conditioner controls in each room of the Club adjusted to their posted temperatures. The smoker urn shall be moved outside the Club prior to the meeting and moved back into the Club following the meeting. After the meeting, the coffee maker shall be cleaned and turned off and the outside door shall be locked and checked from the outside.
- (7) The Club shall have the authority to determine the appropriate discipline in the event of a violation by any person or Group of the Club Rules. The discipline may include, but is not limited to, a temporary or permanent suspension of a person's or Group's privileges to attend or hold meetings at the Club or to be present at the Club and the Club activities.
